

# **INVITATION TO BID**

## **Concord Regional Solid Waste / Resource Recovery Cooperative Access Roadway – New Hampshire Cooperative Recycling Facility**

Sealed proposals for the Access Roadway-New Hampshire Cooperative Recycling Facility will be received at the offices of the CRSW / RRC ("The Owner"), 347-B Village Street, Penacook, New Hampshire 03303 until Wednesday, October 26, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. Bids received after the specified time will not be accepted.

The Access Roadway-New Hampshire Cooperative Recycling Facility construction project, will include construction of approximately 1,600 linear feet of public roadway which will be an extension of Whitney Road in the Penacook area of Concord, NH constructed in accordance with City of Concord roadway standards and will serve as a public access roadway to the New Hampshire Cooperative's Recycling Facility. The project will include roadway construction, extension of public sewerage, water main relocation, storm water management systems including water quality unit, and rehabilitation of an existing 96" culvert for Burnham Brook.

Contract award, agreement execution and notice to proceed are anticipated to be completed in November and December 2011, while site construction is intended to begin on or before March 12, 2012. Since time is of the essence, all work must be substantially completed by October 1, 2012. The Contractor should note that liquidated damages in the amount of \$1,000/day will be levied for every calendar day in excess of the specified contract times.

Bidders will be required to furnish a bid bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid, and the successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities in any or all proposals, to reject any or all proposals, or accept any proposal submitted for the project, as deemed by the Owner to be in its best interests based upon qualifications, experience, demonstrated ability to perform, cost, and other factors deemed by the Owner to bear on the successful outcome of the Contract.
